The Department of Computer Science and Engineering organized the NavaYug – CSE Clubs (Infinox and Phoenix) Inauguration Function for the academic year 2025–26 with the Induction Program for 3rd Semester on 30th September 2025. The event was anchored by Ms. Theertha and Mr. Shevin from the 7th semester, who skillfully managed the proceedings and coordinated by Dr. Kharmega Sundararaj, Assoc. Professor, Dept. of CSE and Prof. Thara Devi M, Asst. Professor, Dept. of CSE. The event was conducted in two sessions – morning and afternoon – and featured a blend of formal, cultural, and interactive activities, celebrating the beginning of a new academic year 2025-26.
